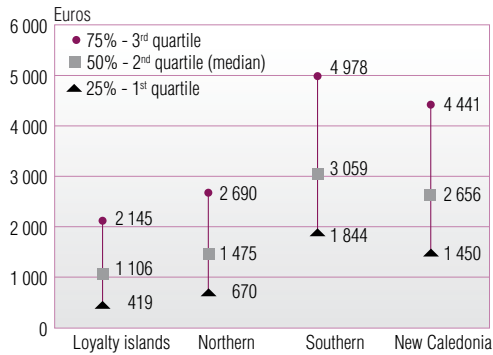


## 12.2 Monetary income (2)

Monthly monetary income dispersal by province in 2008 [1]



Example : a quarter of the households of the Loyalty islands province earns less than 419 Euros per month (1<sup>st</sup> quartile), the next quarter earns between 419 and 1 106 Euros (2<sup>nd</sup> quartile), the next quarter between 1 106 and 2 145 Euros (3<sup>rd</sup> quartile) and finally a quarter of the most well off, earns more than 2 145 Euros per month.

Gini coefficient by province [1]

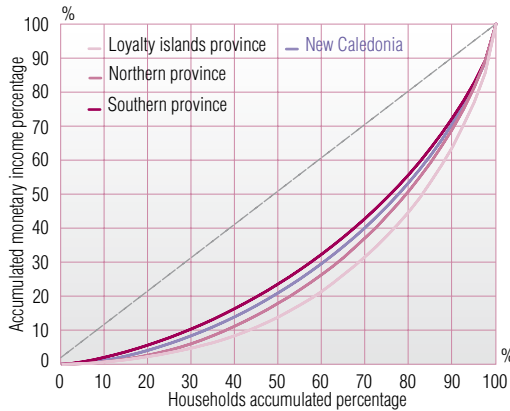
